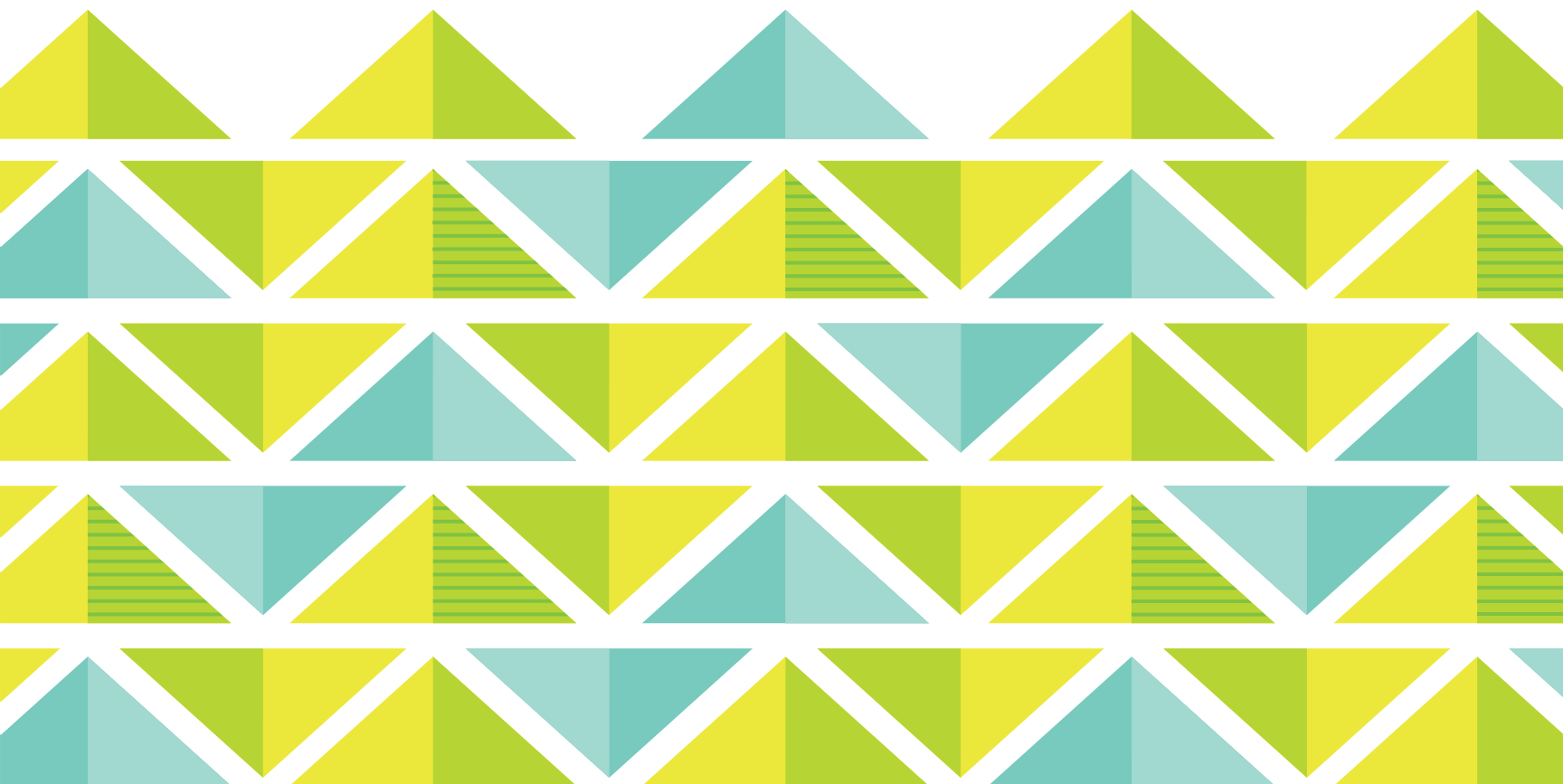

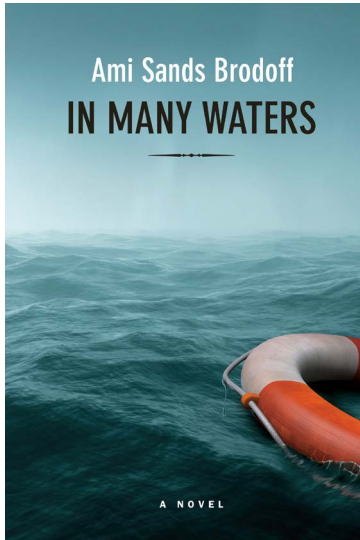

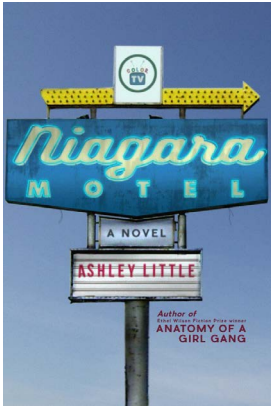

*In Many Waters* is the gripping story of three orphans whose lives intersect on the island of Malta during our current, urgent refugee crisis. Zoe, a budding historian, comes to Malta with her younger brother, Cal, to learn more about their Maltese mother, as well as the mysterious circumstances surrounding their parents’ untimely deaths. The siblings’ well-mapped plans are derailed when Cal, who is a daily swimmer in the Mediterranean, discovers a girl floating in the sea, barely alive. The small, battered fishing boat on which she has journeyed from Libya to Malta capsized in a storm: Aziza is the sole survivor. Meanwhile, Zoe returns to the site of her parents’ drownings and stumbles across a trail of clues that lead to the discovery of an unknown family member, unearthing a chain of life-changing secrets. *In Many Waters* brilliantly mines the hearts and minds of characters in extremis, the unforgettable tale of the ways that we love and help one another, and how the choices we make reverberate through generations.



**AMI SANDS BRODOFF** is the award-winning author of three novels and a volume of stories. Her previous novel, *The White Space Between*, about a mother and daughter struggling with the impact of the Holocaust, won The Canadian Jewish Literary Award for Fiction. *Bloodknots*, a volume of thematically linked stories about families on the edge, was a finalist for The ReLit Award. Ami’s debut novel, *Can You See Me?* was nominated for The Pushcart Prize.

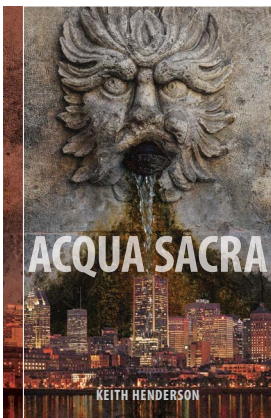

*Acqua Sacra* moves smoothly between Suzanna Ricci's urban Montreal and her ancestral town in Italy. An exciting read.

Old World skepticism kicks at New World concerns in *Acqua Sacra*, Keith Henderson's brisk new novel about private deception and public corruption. His cast includes an honest architect, a gutsy office clerk, the modern-day witch of a drained lake, and at least one (reformed) dirt-digging lawyer. While Montreal's underworld seems as full of venomous snakes and mean dogs as the Abruzzo mountains, Roman history, Italian Mafiosi, dutiful Canadians, and migrant African workers collide, headlong and bizarrely comedic. At the centre of the crash, stunned and sheep-like, lies Suzanna Ricci. Henderson delivers an entertaining and perceptive story about the nature of personal responsibility, this time in an age of multinational delinquency.

Set in postwar Communist Hungary, in the fictional town of Békes, *Never, Again* is the story of seven-year-old Tomi Wolfstein, the son of Holocaust survivors who have never told him anything about their past experiences in the concentration camps. The story opens in the fall of 1956, when Tomi is about to start school, and chronicles his adventures and experiences in the months leading up to and during the Hungarian uprising. *Never, Again* is Tomi's journey—physical, emotional and symbolic—from innocence to experience. It is about the complexities of being a child during turbulent times. It is about faith, prejudice, ignorance, hate, and nationalism, as well as kindness, loyalty, courage, and hope.
