The Eyes that Shone is Philip's souvenir of his life with Nancy and the legacy she left for her family and friends.



The Hüglins had lost most of their fortune in the course of two world wars, and the Wachendorffs had survived the Nazi years despite their Jewish ancestry. The family's roots are traced back to a vineyard in southern Germany, a jail in Geneva, the Conservatory in St. Petersburg, and to the hometown of a Jewish merchant in Silesia. From the vantage point of the author's adult life in Canada, the book centres on his recollections of his grandparents, parents, and his own growing up in postwar Germany.
